

# **REGULATIONS FOR CHELTENHAM CIVIL SERVICE TENNIS CLUB MEMBERS DURING COVID-19 RESTRICTION.**

## **THESE DIRECTIONS ARE TO BE ADHERED TO:**

### **TENNIS ACTIVITY**

**Entrance to the club is by foot only through the opening between the two double gates with all cars/bicycles to be left at the entrance by the main road or the Gallagher Retail Park.**

- As per government guidelines play is limited to no more than two people per court (other than where players are from the same household)
- No extra-curricular or social activity should take place
- If you do have symptoms of COVID-19 you are not to enter the court and if these symptoms have occurred subsequent to any time spent on these courts you are to notify the COVID-19 rep so we can advise those who were on court at the time.

### **COURT ACCESS**

- There are no changing or toilet facilities available.
- Play is restricted to Tues/Wed/Fri/Sat/Sun between the hours of 10-7.
- Only enter and exit the courts through the main entrance by the clubhouse. The clubhouse is to remain closed except for emergencies.
- The court gates should be left open during playing time unless you are leaving and no one else is present where you should then secure the gate and the key
- Only courts 1 and 4 are to be used.
- Do not enter courts until the players from the court you are booked or have left the entrance.
- Always use sanitiser on entry to the courts as per government guidance.

### **EQUIPMENT**

- Players should bring their own equipment - it is advised to avoid use of communal rackets or tennis balls
- Use of coaching equipment (e.g. cones) should be limited, with any equipment used cleaned and wiped down afterwards
- When playing please observe rules on using your own balls which should be easily identifiable as your own and change ends at opposite sides of the net. Use your racket or feet to return balls to another player that are not yours.
- Nets should be left up and the winders not used.

### **BOOKINGS**

- This is now compulsory so we can track usage of the courts and is done through ClubSpark. You need to be a member of the club to book and the list of the 33 current paid up members have been sent a invite to join the booking system. You will receive an e-mail back confirming booking has been accepted. Any issues with ClubSpark please let myself or Gav us know as I know there have been teething problems,

Anyone not adhering to these rules will be blocked from being able to book courts in the future.
